Azerbaijan

Azərbaycan Radiosu is the state radio service of Azerbaijan TV and Radio Broadcasting. It appears that all broadcasting from Azərbaycan Radiosu on mediumwave and shortwave has ceased (mediumwave stations were last heard in 2016 and appear to have been decommissioned in favour of FM since then).

Radio Ictimai

Radio Ictimai is a Baku-based FM station that is also irregularly heard on shortwave with a wideband FM transmission to interfere with broadcasts from Voice of Justice and Voice of Talyshistan (see below). It was last heard on 9677v kHz on 20 May 2017 by Ivo Ivanov/SWLDX-Bulgaria

Nagorno-Karabakh

Nagorno-Karabakh is a landlocked region in the South Caucasus. It is internationally recognized as part of Azerbaijan, but most of the region is governed by the Nagorno-Karabakh Republic, a de facto independent nation established on the basis of the Nagorno-Karabakh Autonomous Oblast of the Azerbaijan Soviet Socialist Republic. Azerbaijan has not exercised political authority over the region since the advent of the Karabakh movement in 1988. (Wikipedia).

Voice of Justice

Voice of Justice started broadcasting in August 1997 to promote a better understanding between Azerbaijan and Armenia on the Nagorno-Karabakh issue. It has been several years since Voice of Justice has been positively heard on shortwave, with Voice of Talyshistan the most likely to have been using the transmitter at Stepanakert in recent years.

Target Broadcast to Bahrain

Call of Bahrain (Neda al-Bahrain)

Call of Bahrain is a programme aired over the transmitters of IRIB (Iran) to listeners in Bahrain. The purpose of the broadcast is described on www.nedaalbahrain.com as follows: "With the rise of the Islamic awakening in the world, which came to an end with the dawn of the Islamic revolution in Iran, our Islamic civilization has begun to revive the climate of return to Islam, which provides civilized solutions to the problems of economy, society, politics, education and so on. Despite the imperialist, Zionist and reactionary reaction to the wave of Islamic awakening, our various countries and societies continue to live in this tendency and tendencies at different rates. Bahrain is considered one of the countries in which the Islamic revolution was influenced by the faith of the people of this island, which quickly interacted with the Qur'anic verse of the Islamic Revolution. Today, nearly six years after the start of the popular revolution in Bahrain led by Grand Ayatollah Ali Issa Qassim, this revolution, despite its peaceful nature, is still facing a repressive escalation by the ruling regime. Therefore, in the light of recent developments in the region and particularly in Bahrain, an effective action was needed to bring the oppressed voice of the oppressed and the oppressed in this kingdom to the world to stop the blatant violations and violations committed by the ruling authority through its security services against the peaceful and genuine demands for human rights. This is a duty guaranteed by international law and believes in all divine laws. The idea of establishing the "Call of Bahrain" is a voice for truth and a voice for Muslims who suffer injustice and abuse by an authority that regards itself as a civilized state in the international system. And deprive them of the most basic rights of citizenship and plunge them into their dark prisons to practice various kinds of torture against them and their families".

Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus

Bayrak Radio and Television Corporation is the official radio and television broadcasting corporation of the self-proclaimed Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus. All stations now operate on FM. BRTK had broadcast on shortwave 6150 kHz from a 25 kW transmitter, but it is now inactive.

Georgia

Georgian Public Broadcaster is the public broadcasting service in Georgia. It operates two radio channels: Sakartvelos Radio - Pirveli Radio and Radio Ori - Kartuli Radio, both on FM. GPB also operated the international channel Radio Georgia, which closed down in 2005.

Abkhazia

Abkhazia is a partially recognised state controlled by a separatist government on the eastern coast of the Black Sea and the south-western flank of the Caucasus. It considers itself an independent state, called the Republic of Abkhazia or Apsny. This status is recognised by Russia, Nicaragua, Venezuela, Nauru and also by the partially recognised state of South Ossetia and the unrecognised Transnistria and Nagorno-Karabakh. The Georgian government, the United Nations and the majority of the world's governments consider Abkhazia a part of Georgia's territory, though Georgia does not control it. Under Georgia's official designation it is an autonomous republic, called the Autonomous Republic of Abkhazia.

Abkhaz Radio (Apsua Radio)

Abkhaz Radio has been on the air since 1992 broadcasting from Sukhumi, capital of the self-declared Republic of Abkhazia in NW Georgia. Using transmitters on mediumwave and shortwave it broadcasts programmes in Abkhaz, Georgian and Russian, and when not carrying its own programmes relays various others services from the neighbouring Russian North Caucasus region. The confirmed schedule for Abkhaz Radio in early October on 1350 kHz is shown below.

It is also among the largest media organisations in Asian and Pacific region. IRIB is independent of the Iranian government. It provides

IRIB Radio Iran

Radio Iran is IRIB's main radio service with news, talk and information in Persian. It broadcasts throughout Iran around the clock on mediumwave and FM. It is also relayed by many provincial stations at certain times of the day and overnight. Radio Iran's main mediumwave frequency is 558 kHz, with transmitters in other locations likely to move there in future.

Israel

Israeli Public Broadcasting Corporation, branded as **Kan**, is an Israeli governmental body founded in 2015. It was founded with the intent to replace the Israel Broadcasting Authority (IBA) after the Israeli Public Broadcasting law ordered its closure. Its debut date was postponed several times but eventually opened on 15 May 2017.

Pilgrimage Enlightenment Radio Radio Jeddah had for several years broadcast a seasonal service called Pilgrimage Enlightenment Radio to serve Hajj pilgrims and observers. It had religious programmes in eight languages during the Hajj season. Besides Arabic, programmes were in English, French, Persian, Turkish, Hausa, Indonesian and Urdu and were tailored to ensure the pilgrims' proper orientation and enlightenment in topics related to the performance of pilgrimage. It broadcast live comprehensive coverage of Hajj, including traffic reports, movement of pilgrims, weather conditions, safety precautions, and interviews with experts, scholars and pilgrims. In addition to religious programmes, PER broadcast live coverage of the days of Tarwiyah, the stay at Arafat, the Eid prayer from the holy Mosque, and the three days of Tashreeq. It had broadcast on mediumwave 594 and 1017 kHz but is now believed to have been discontinued, with 594 kHz now carrying Radio Neda al-Islam (Radio Call of Islam) from Mecca instead.

Republic of Yemen Radio - Radio Sana'a

Republic of Yemen Radio is the state broadcasting service of Yemen. During the current crisis in the country all mediumwave and shortwave transmitters are believed to be inactive. However, there is a radio station of the same name currently broadcasting to Yemen, presumably from neighbouring Saudi Arabia, in support of Yemeni President Abdrabbuh Mansur Hadi.

Republic of Yemen Radio - Radio Sana'a - Pro-Hadi

Chris Greenway reported via DX Listening Digest on 20 October 2015 the existence of a broadcast on shortwave in support of Yemeni President Abdrabbuh Mansur Hadi. President Hadi was deposed by Houthi rebels in 2014 and subsequently fled to Saudi Arabia in March 2015. Tarek Zeidan reported an ID from the station on 20 October 2015 as "Huna Sana'a idhaat aljumphuriya alyamaniya al bernamaj al a'am" ("This is Sana'a, Republic of Yemen Radio General Programme"). According to an online source the pro-Hadi transmission on shortwave is from Aden, but based on the fact that Yemen is having problems with power and a lot of blackouts, leaving the greater part of Yemen without electricity, it must be coming from a nearby country, presumably Saudi Arabia.

Transmitter site: subject to confirmation, but believed to be in Saudi Arabia; monitoring observations by Ivo Ivanov (SWLDX-Bulgaria) suggest that this service may switch from one transmitter to another at certain times of the day. The following schedule was noted by Ivo on 26 August 2017:
